

Dear Applicant,

Frontier Country Soccer Association (FCSA) welcomes you to apply for the yearly scholarship for graduating seniors who are going to attend college. The application needs to be postmarked by the deadline date. Any applications that are not postmarked accordingly may be refused by the scholarship committee. Should the application arrive late and then refused, it will be kept and unopened. All applications will become the property of FCSA.

A copy of your high school transcript is required to apply for this scholarship. The transcript can arrive separately (i.e. mailed directly from the school) but will still have the postmark requirements.

Because the scholarships are primarily funded by the Day of Champions and Oklahoma Cup Tournaments, participation weighs heavily. The FCSA Board of Directors has determined that the players and teams that attend the tournaments, and thereby provide the money, should be the primary benefactors of the scholarship fund.

The FCSA Board of Directors encourages the players to become involved in his or her respective clubs. Therefore, referee and coaching experience at the club level is also to be taken into consideration.

Another direction the FCSA Board of Directors has chosen is to give one scholarship each to the top scoring male and female applicants. This goes from a scholarship that would buy a book or two to one that will significantly reduce the applicant's financial burden.

The FCSA Scholarship is awarded based on participation in the sport of youth soccer, not an award of one's playing ability. Participation in soccer at the college level will have no bearing on who will receive the award, nor will receiving the award have any bearing on playing at the college level.

The FCSA Scholarship Committee will examine each application. All information will need to be verified. The evidence that is supplied with the application will assist the committee. Any and all information that is not verified will not be considered. The committee will use your information, as well as your proof, along with the records kept at FCSA and the Oklahoma Soccer Association. The committee will not contact you for more information. Everything needed will have to have been submitted by the deadline.

Please return (after making a copy for your records) this letter and application.

All information submitted has been done so to the best of the knowledge of the applicant. Applicant acknowledges that any misleading or incorrect information can lead to denial of the application. Applicant in no way holds FCSA liable for information that is not verifiable. Nor does the applicant hold FCSA liable for any judgment decisions by the committee.
