Club Competitive Commissioners must ensure that this form is completed and electronically submitted to FCSA by midnight on May 1, 2010.

TRYOUT DATES:

U11-U14: June 26, 2010-July 5, 2010, with final registration due by July 16, 2010.

Pre-contact period date is June 1, 2010- June 16, 2010.

Competitive dead week June 17-24, 2010. Contact day by phone only June 25, 2010.

U15-U19: June 27, 2010-July 5, 2010, with final registration due by July 16, 2010.

Pre-contact period date is June 1, 2010- June 16, 2010.

Competitive dead week June 17-24, 2010. Contact day by phone only June 25, 2010.

For U19 teams only, a special team registration period exists from January 1 to one week prior to the roster freeze date set by OSA.

INSTRUCTIONS (see also page 2 for more detailed instructions):

- Only one team per form – Complete all questions – Mark “N/A” for any questions that do not apply.
- Completed Forms will only be accepted if attached as a MS Word documents to an e-mail or provide on a disc.
- Completed Forms will only be accepted from your club's Competitive Commissioners, after their review.
- Any incomplete form will be returned to the Club Competitive Commissioner by e-mail.
- All Coaches and Trainers must have a D or higher soccer license, except if the one time – one-year exception under the Bylaws applies. If not already on file with FCSA, a copy of the Coaches and Trainers soccer license must be provided to FCSA by May 1, 2010.

PER FCSA BYLAWS/RULES:

- A competitive team of a FCSA Club must submit this form and be in the FCSA published tryout circular in order to register for the seasonal year.
- Once a coach or trainer is submitted to FCSA, they will not be allowed to coach or train another club's competitive team of the same age and gender for the remainder of that seasonal year.
- No forms with “To be Announced” coaches will be accepted.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE FCSA COMPETITIVE TRYOUT INFORMATION FORM

- Only one team per form.
 - Once complete, save your form in an MS Word format, attach it to an email and send it to your Competitive Commissioner.
 - The Club Competitive Commissioner will review the form for completeness/accuracy and submit to FCSA.
 - The completed forms must be returned to FCSA by midnight on May 1, 2010.
 - Any questions you have concerning this form or tryouts in general should be directed to your Club Competitive Commissioner.
- **Club Name:** This is the name of the Club you will register and play under (i.e. North OKC, South Lakes, Mustang, Norman, Edmond, etc.) If unsure, ask your Club's Competitive Commissioner.
 - **Club Phone:** List the main phone number for the Club.
 - **Age Group:** U11, U12, U13, etc
 - **Age Designation:** 94, 93, 92, 91, etc.
 - **Gender:** Boys or Girls
 - **Team Name:** How will the team be known? What will they be called? For example, Cosmos 92, Celtic Green 94, CVFC 93 etc.
 - **Team Hotline:** This is usually a number players can call to hear a recording for team information.
 - **Team Web Page:** List only the webpage that relate to the specific team being advertised. The Club web page will be advertised elsewhere.
 - **Coach Name:** List the primary/head coach for the team.
 - **Coach License:** List the current soccer license held by the listed Coach.
 - **Coach Address:** Provide the Street, City, State and Zip Code of the listed Coach.
 - **Coach Phone:** List the phone number where players are most like to reach the listed Coach or can leave a message to request information.
 - **Coach E-mail:** The listed Coach's primary e-mail address or, if he/she doesn't have one, the address of the manager or Club office where messages can be forwarded to you.
 - **Trainer Name:** List the trainer for the team, if different than the Coach.
 - **Trainer License:** List the current soccer license held by the listed Trainer.
 - **Trainer Address:** Provide the City, State and Zip Code of the listed Trainer.
 - **Trainer Phone:** List the phone number where players are most like to reach the listed Trainer or can leave a message to request information.
 - **Trainer E-mail:** The listed Trainer's primary e-mail address or, if he/she doesn't have one, the address of the manager or Club office where messages can be forwarded to you.
 - **Tryout Location/Field Number:** The location, including field number, where your tryouts will be held.
 - **Tryout Dates & Times:** List as many as you reasonably expect to have. Some established teams may only have two or three, and some teams will list several days and use them for practice once the team is filled. There is no need to list more than you feel you will need. All listed tryouts will be published by FCSA. After the start of the Annual Tryout Period, the team's club may authorize additional tryouts not submitted on this form; however, these additional tryouts will not be published by FCSA.
 - **Club Fees:** These are fees that the player's parents can expect to pay either one time only or once each season, usually at registration. This should include all referee fees. Do not include uniforms. Answer "Y" for Yes and "N" for No, so as to reflect whether the listed Club Fees are **Per Season** or **Per Year**.
 - **Monthly Training Fee:** These are the fees that the player's parents can expect to pay for training fees each month. Answer "Y" for Yes and "N" for No, so as to reflect whether the listed Training Fees are **Per Player** or **Per Team**.
 - **Other Monthly Fees:** These are any additional fees a player's parents can expect to pay on a monthly basis. These would include any reoccurring cost like a team fee, etc. Do not include any one time costs like uniforms or variable cost like tournaments.
